CHILDREN'S CANCER NETWORK is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to providing assistance to families dealing with childhood cancer. We provide financial support to these families, promote patient and family education regarding cancer related issues and sponsor activities that build the self esteem of childhood cancer patients and their siblings.

Established in 2004, Children's Cancer Network grew from the inspiration of Jenny Luttrell, a high school student. The idea to help children with cancer came about while visiting her brother, a bone marrow transplant patient fighting leukemia. During her brother's stay in the hospital, a young girl in the room next to him passed away. Jenny was distressed that the young girl's parents did not have money for gasoline to make the drive back to their home town and had to deal with this stress at a time they were grieving for the loss of their daughter. Jenny dreamed of hosting a fashion show using childhood cancer patients and their siblings and family members as models. Funds raised from the fashion show would be provided to families in need, dealing with childhood cancer. The vision of Children's Cancer Network was born that day.
